- Does the song tell a story?

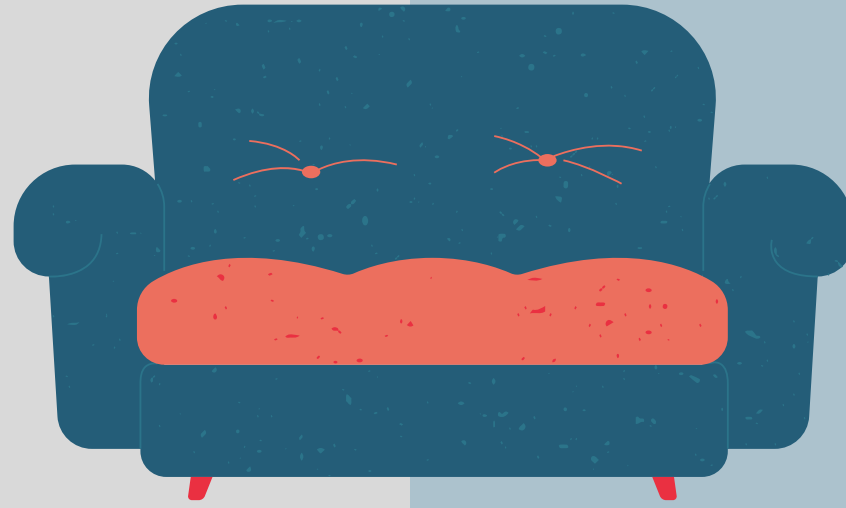
extension activity

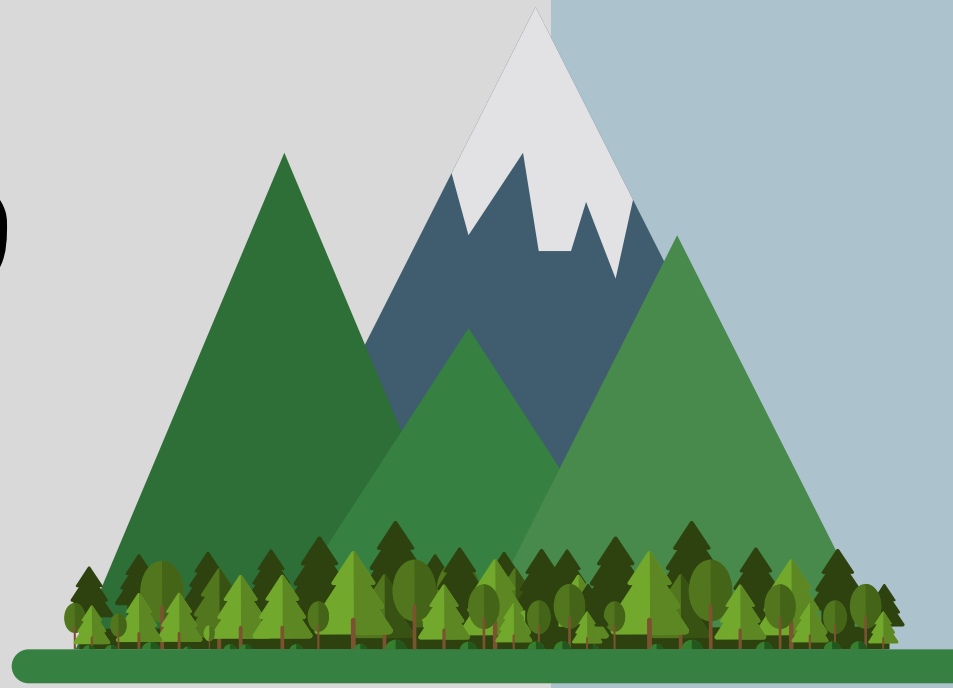
SONG - WONDERFUL LIFE- SMALL FOOT

There's nothing wrong with that

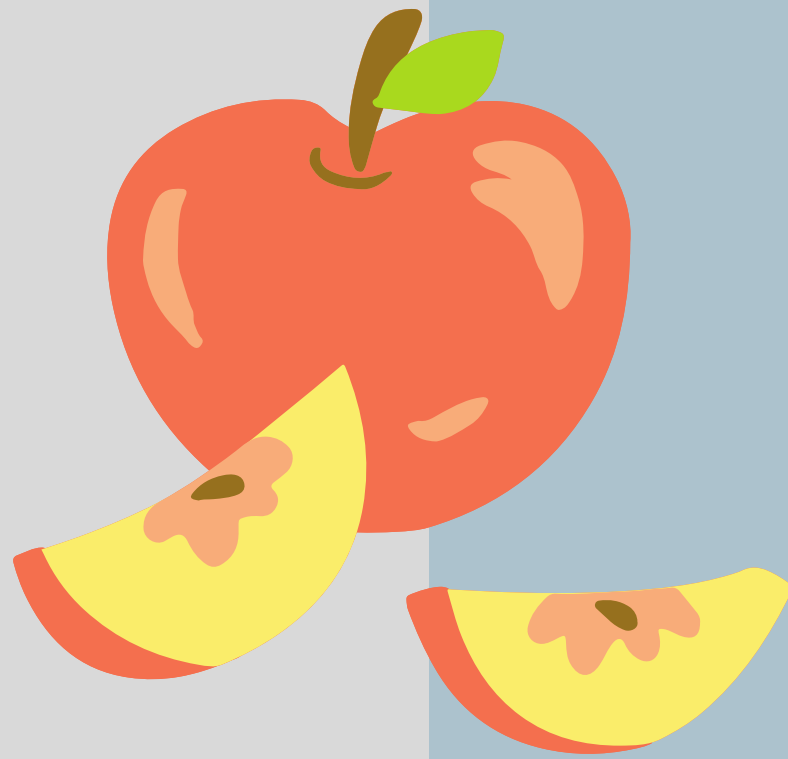

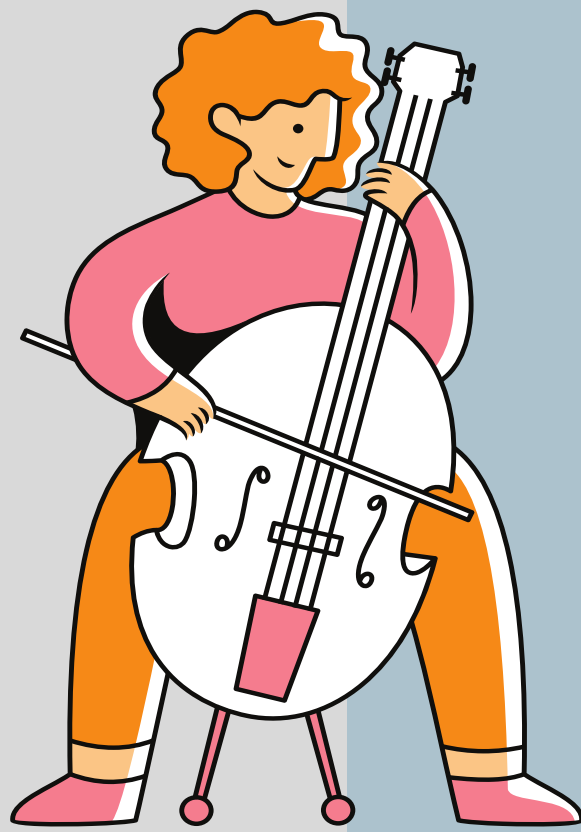

extension activity - Year 1

extension activity - Year 2 & 3

- Let's plan our own instrumental master piece!

- Also suggest how they would play the instruments (fast, slow, quiet, loud, scratchy, plodding, short, long, energetically, lethargic).

extension activity
